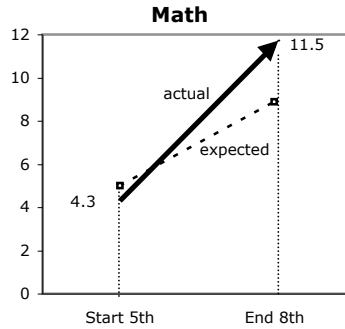
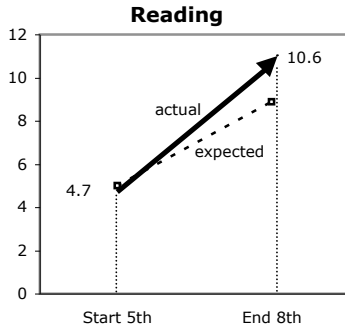


Mean Grade Equivalent (GE) Test Scores

A grade equivalent (GE) is a score reported on norm-referenced tests that allows you to compare students based on the performance of other students relative to the school year. Based on a 9-month school year (typically September through May), the score represents a period during the school year, displayed as a number to show a grade and a month. Therefore, students should make one year of growth each school year.

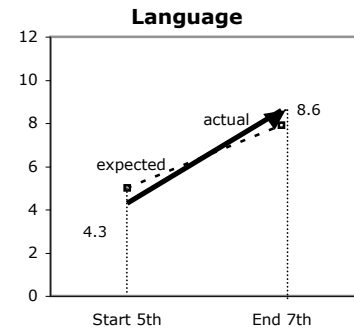
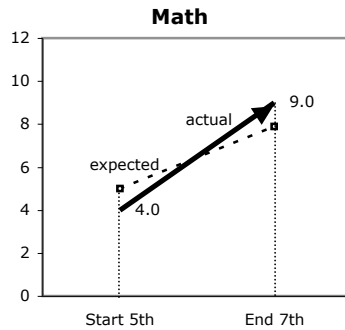
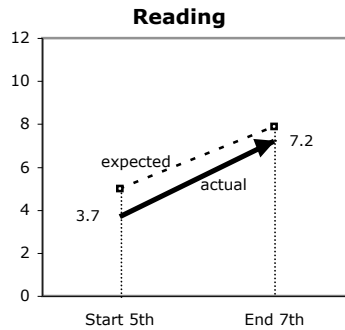
