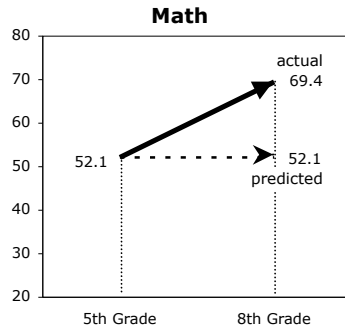
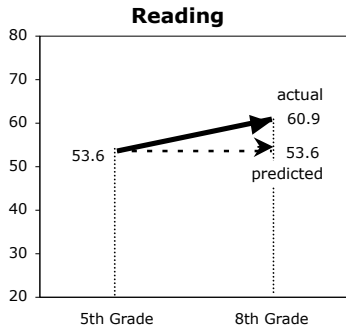


Mean Normal Curve Equivalent (NCE) Test Scores

Mean Normal Curve Equivalent (NCE) scores are used to evaluate achievement gains by a cohort of students (class) as they advance grade levels. NCE scores are predicted to remain the same for each class of students over time, while an increase in NCE scores (actual scores shown below) indicate academic growth that is above and beyond that of elementary students across the nation.

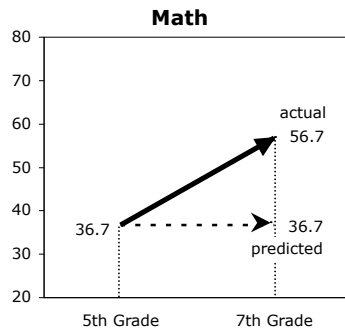
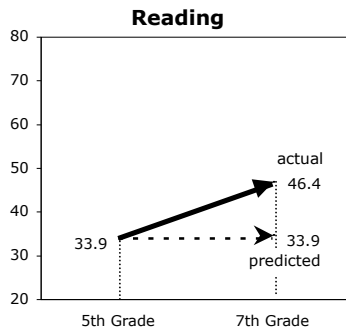
